I extend my sincerest support for The Volcano Project's bid on the Volcano House concession management contract. The Volcano Project is proposing the historic Volcano House be managed by a local, community-based 501(c)3 non-profit organization. Through this non-profit system of management, 100% of all profits will remain within Kilauea to directly benefit Hawai'i Volcanoes National Park as well as the surrounding community.

I support this proposal that focuses on creating jobs as well as educational and economic opportunities.
